Brad Torres has been spending his quarantine time building up his online reputation and creating new art at breakneck speed. This will come to a crux when he stages a brand new, wholly original musical, using only artists stuck in quarantine and digital live-stream broadcasting technology. Brad has already teased some of his compositions in previous live digital performances, a medium more and more artists are needing to use to safeguard themselves financially during the pandemic. Brad has promised the show will mount on April 30th, 2020.
